Directions for use

GENERAL REMARKS:

Stir well before using.

The surfaces to be painted have to be clean, dry and suitably primed.

This paint is unsuitable for application on glossy mosaic pavements..

BARE SURFACES:

Porous tile, old mosaic pavements:If floors have been treated with waxes or polishing products or are greasy, wash them with a 10% sodium phosphate solution in hot water; rinse with abundant water and let to thoroughly dry (minimum 48 hours).Clean with TITAN Turpentine to remove any trace of waxes or grease. If elimination is not total, a defective adhesion of

paint will be produced.

After thoroughly cleaning and removing dust, apply TITAN Paint for Floors by thin coats.

MAINTENANCE OF PREVIOUSLY COATED SURFACES IN GOOD CONDITION:

Wash, lightly sand, remove dust and directly apply one thin coat of TITAN Paint for Floors.

MAINTENANCE OF PREVIOUSLY COATED SURFACES IN POOR CONDITION:

Completely remove all previous paint coats and proceed as for bare surfaces.
