GENERAL REMARKS:

Shake well before use. Maximum amount of mixture: 5% in volume. Do not use this product directly, without adding it to paints. Mix the tint and the base paint or varnish, if possible by means of a mechanical shaker.

Store in tightly closed containers protected from sources of heat and temperatures below 0°C. Shelf life: 36 months in original unopened packaging.
